SUZANNE (SUZI) LEDGER

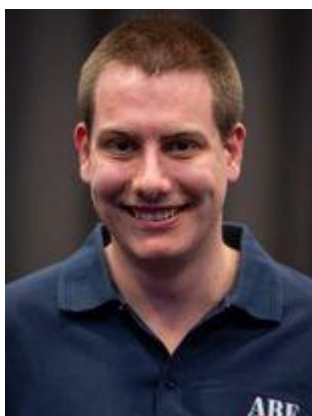
